Worship Reader

Task

- Duties include reading the designated lessons for the worship service.
- Readers will receive the lessons via email the week prior to their scheduled reading.
- Readers should read through the lesson prior to the service and practice any unknown words and any inflection that helps with the understanding and interest in the reading.

Impact

- 1. Worship Readers are an integral part of the worship service and are an important part of sharing the Word.
- 2. Your service will provide a valuable understanding of the Word.
- 3. Your service will provide a valuable and recognizable component of the worship service.
- 4. Your service will provide Advent Lutheran Church with responsible leadership and support the pastor and the congregation during the worship service.

Timeframe

- 1. The position is shared between interested members of the congregation and continues for as long as a member is willing to be a reader.
- 2. The time involved is usually less than 10 -20 minutes of preparation the week before the reading and readers usually rotate in every 6 to 8 weeks.

Check-ins

The Worship Committee or Pastor will arrange the schedule and notify readers of their assignments. The office manager will email the assigned readings during the week prior.
